## Open Access to Published Research

To support PolyU academic community in disseminating research results widely and freely, at its 187th meeting on 20 January 2010, the Research Committee (RC) considered and pproved the following open access policy for implementation from the beginning of the age/RPg I imetable/) 2010/11 academic year:

PolyU academic and researchers are required to deposit electronic copies of their peerreviewed journal articles and conference proceedings (author's final accepted manuscript) in the PolyU Institutional Repository (PolyU IR) (currently known as PolyU Research Archive, PolyU IRA) (http://ira.lib.polyu.edu.hk/) for open access, as of the date of paper publication. Full text of other research outputs should also be deposited where appropriate.

PolyU authors will provide to the University Library copies of their work and the University Library will determine publisher agreements permit deposit in institutional repositories for public access. PolyU IRA staff will check publishers' copyright agreements to ensure that the deposits are permitted.
