

## Open Access – what is it?

Open access means the free dissemination of scientific knowledge. A scientific publication is freely available, when both the academic community and general public have unrestricted online access to it.

Open access is a fundamental principle of science and research. Scientific publications produced at the University of Turku must be made freely accessible if allowed by the terms of the publisher. To find practical information on open access at the University of Turku, read the library's Open access publishing guide.

Library promotes open access by providing services for the open access publishing of theses and for depositing the publication's parallel copy into the open repository of the University of Turku.
